Information On Your Charitable Bequest

Your charitable bequest is a very important vehicle for building Vista Center's future. When received, your gift will be used at the discretion of the Board of Directors or can be designated to our endowment fund if you wish.

There are several ways to provide Vista Center a testamentary gift. One way this can be accomplished is through your beneficiary designation of your retirement plan, IRA, life insurance and/or annuities. Gifts of this kind may be beneficial to you because no estate or income taxes are paid on the benefits received by Vista Center.

Another way to accomplish a gift is through your will or trust. Designating a percentage allows your gift to appreciate in your will no matter what asset is used. You may also wish to give a specific amount.
