We hope this message finds you healthy during these challenging times as we all cope with COVID-19. Our clinic team has implemented the following protocol to ensure the safety and well-being of our patients and staff during your appointment in our Low Vision Clinic.

- We will ask you a few questions over the phone to ensure you are healthy prior to coming in for an appointment.
- We will also perform an in-person temperature screening once you arrive for your appointment and your hands will be sanitized with a spritz solution.
- Staff will be wearing protective masks/face shields. In addition, we will require you to wear your own personal mask or facial covering. If you have trouble breathing or are on oxygen, we will provide a face shield for you to wear during your appointment. <u>You will not be</u> <u>allowed to enter our agency without a</u> <u>mask or face shield.</u>



- In order to adhere to social distancing, please call us from your car when you arrive. We will call you when our staff is ready to check you in.
- Family members or caregivers accompanying you will be kindly asked to wait in the car. Only one family member or caregiver will be allowed to accompany you and <u>only when necessary</u>.
- All rooms utilized by our patients will be extensively sanitized between patient visits.
